Probability trees are similar to frequency trees, but we instead put the probabilities on the branches and the events at the end of the branch.. Example: A bag contains 4 red balls and 5 blue balls. Raheem picks 2 balls at random.. Calculate the probability that he selects the same coloured ball each time, given that after each time a ball is selected, it is replaced.

Frequency Trees (F)

Here is a typical question you should try on conditional probability. Try it before looking at the worked solution. Susan goes to work by one of two routes A or B. The probability of going by route A is 30%. If she goes by route A the probability of being late for school is 5% and if she goes by route B, the probability of being late is 10%.

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
