Examples: hoping, joked, believable #5 If a word ends with a silent e, do not drop the e when adding a suffix that begins with a consonant. Examples: careless, safety, arrangement. Spelling Strategies for More Suffixes #6 When the suffix -ly is added to a word, the spelling of the base word does not usually change.
